YOUTH CAREER MENTORING PROGRAM!**

Baltimore City’s water industry offers access to entry-level job opportunities and to stable, well-paying careers with potential job growth and advancement.

Through the Career Mentoring Program, participants receive basic job readiness training, plus:

- *Water industry career exploration*
- *Worksite tours and job shadowing experiences*
- *Connection with a career coach/mentor*
- *A summer job through YouthWorks*
- *Opportunities to interview for full-time, entry-level positions*



The program is open to young adults between the ages of 18 and 24, with a high school diploma or GED, and who are unemployed or underemployed, and are not currently engaged in job training or post-secondary education.

Applications accepted from Monday, Jan. 23 to Friday, Feb. 10, 2017. The program begins Feb. 21 and runs through Friday, Aug. 11, 2017.

Classes are held Mondays & Tuesdays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. (six hours a week)

NOTE: A driver’s license is preferred, but not required.

Outcome: To date, 26 Baltimore City residents between the ages of 18 and 24 have completed the Baltimore City Water Industry Youth Career Mentoring Program and are employed in full-time jobs within the water industry.
